SUMMARY

Base Camp is the main music stage for Bear Shadow weekend. Base Camp will be located at <u>Winfield Farm</u>, 250 Winfield Farm Road, just 12 minutes from Downtown Highlands, in Scaly Mountain, NC. This beautiful location offers proximity to Highlands, increased on-site parking, epic views and plenty of space to enjoy the music safely. Base Camp live music will be 5:30-10pm each evening and guests will sit in socially-distanced COVEs of 4, 6, or 8 people. COVEs will not have seating and are not covered. Guests are encouraged to bring their own bagged chairs or blankets for seating options.

All guests will be subject to COVID questionnaires and temperature checks prior to boarding shuttles or in guest parking lot. We ask that masks be worn at all times during the festival, except when eating or drinking **INSIDE** your designated COVE. Please read below all important information for your Base Camp Experience, as a General Admission ticket holder.

YOUR COVE

All guests will be assigned in advance to a 4, 6, or 8-person COVE (Contained Outdoor Viewing Environment). These will be 10'x10' square. There WILL NOT be chairs in your COVE. Guests will need to bring bagged chairs, blankets, or other items to make your COVE comfortable. All items must be carried and set up by guests AND all items must fit inside your COVE. Bear Shadow crew cannot assist in set up of COVE seating. *Tents and umbrellas are not allowed.*

Masks can be removed only when inside your COVE.

BEVERAGES & THE BEAR BARN

Upon arrival, all guests will find their COVE stocked with the first round of Wicked Weed Brews on us!

In order to make things more efficient, we will have the following options of wristbands for purchase:

- BEAR BARN ALL ACCESS - \$40 (Beer, wine and spirits you can drink)*

WICKED ONLY ACCESS - \$12 (All the Wicked Weed beer you can drink)*
 *There is a 2 drink limit per BEAR BARN visit.

These wristbands will grant access to the THE BEAR BARN, where you will be served unlimited beer, wine, and spirits for the show. This means less waiting time and more time for you to party!

Options that can be enjoyed at THE BEAR BARN include: Wicked Weed Brews, Tito's Handmade Vodka, Cathead Vodka, The Chemist, Wente Sauvignon Blanc, Austerity Chardonnay, Bogle Rose, Line 39 Pinot Noir, Ravel & Stitch Cabernet Sauvignon and Pizay Morgon, along with other beverage selections.

Bottled water is complimentary during the event. No outside beverages will be allowed!

Cash and credit cards will be accepted for THE BEAR BARN wristbands. We ask that you kindly consume all beverages inside your COVE.



WEATHER

This event is outdoors and will happen rain or shine. Please be prepared for forecasted weather. Should inclement weather arise, all ticket holders will be contacted via email and announcements will be made via social media.

ATTIRE

Casual. This event is outdoors in a grass pasture and uncovered. Please dress accordingly and for forecasted weather.

MERCHANDISE

There will be Bear Shadow and artist merchandise available for purchase on site. Cash and credit cards will be accepted.

ONSITE PARKING

For drivers, upon entry at Winfield Farm, you will be directed to guest parking. You will receive a COVID questionnaire and temp check before you leave your vehicle. There will be a short walk to the concert location and plenty of staff/signage to mark the way.

ADA PARKING

SHUTTLES

We are offering complimentary round-trip shuttles from downtown Highlands to Base Camp Friday-Sunday. Shuttles will run continuously from Kelsey-Hutchinson Park in Highlands from 4:00pm – 10:30pm. You will be required to participate in a COVID questionnaire and temperature check before boarding the shuttle, and masks will be required on board. Shuttles will drop off/pickup guests directly at Base Camp gates.

- Kelsey-Hutchinson Park is located on the 400 block of Pine Street, Highlands.
- Parking is very limited, so please carpool or walk from your lodging.
- You will have to carry your belongings with you on the shuttle, so pack lightly.



RE-ENTRY

Once inside, guests are not allowed to leave and re-enter the event.

TICKETING/WRISTBAND FAQ

For ticket holders, all wristbands will be given at the General Admission Entrance. There is limited cell and Internet service. We recommend you take a screen shot of your tickets or bring a printed copy of your ticket with QR Code from Universe. Universe will automatically send everyone a reminder email 24 hours prior to the event with their purchased tickets. If you do not receive this email, please contact info@bearshadownc.com so tickets can be resent. Ticket sales will close 24 hours prior to the start of the event. Tickets will be scanned at the gate and we will assist you with putting on your wristband. No wristbands will be given without a ticket. There will be no ticket sales onsite.

What do I need to get into the event?

Just your ticket with QR Code.

Do not lose your wristband – these are *non-replaceable*. Individuals not wearing a wristband will not be allowed to stay within the festival, no exceptions. The plastic security lock on the wristband is a one-way lock. Do not play with this lock to tighten the band too much. **No wristbands will be replaced.**

*Treat your wristband like cash – lost, stolen, tampered with, and/or confiscated wristbands will not be replaced!
