If your lodging location permits, we encourage you to walk to Kelsey-Hutchinson Park for shuttles. Otherwise, please park in public spots and note that parking in Highlands can be challenging.

There can be absolutely no guests parking at the Satulah Mountain trailhead. Thank you for your cooperation!

RESTROOMS

There are very nice public restrooms located at Kelsey-Hutchinson Park, where you will be checking in and boarding the shuttle for Satulah Mountain, as well as one porta potty that will be at the beginning of the trail, where you will be dropped off to being your hike. We strongly recommend you take advantage of the restrooms at the park, before leaving for the hike. Once you have hiked to the top of Satulah, your only restroom option will be the one porta potty that is a 15 min hike back to the start of the trail.

WEATHER

This event is weather contingent. If inclement weather arises, guests will be contacted via Universe to notify them of event cancellation. However, tickets holders will still receive gifts from sponsors.
