ONSITE PARKING

Onsite parking is limited and parking passes will need to be purchased in order to park at Winfield Farm. We highly encourage parking in Highlands with complimentary shuttles to Base Camp, more information below. For drivers, upon entry at Winfield Farm, you will be directed to guest parking. There will be a short walk to the concert location and plenty of staff/signage to mark the way.

SHUTTLES

We are offering complimentary round-trip shuttles from downtown Highlands to Base Camp Friday-Sunday. Shuttles will run continuously from Kelsey-Hutchinson Park and the Highlands Community Center in Highlands from 4:00pm – 11:00pm Friday and Saturday and from 11:00am - 6:00pm on Sunday. Shuttles will drop off/pickup guests directly at Base Camp gates.

- Kelsey-Hutchinson Park is located on the 400 block of Pine Street, Highlands.
- Highlands Community Center is located at 869 N. 4th Street. T
- Parking is very limited, so please carpool or walk from your lodging.
- You will have to carry your belongings with you on the shuttle, so pack lightly and be courteous of other guests.

RE-ENTRY

Once inside, guests are not allowed to leave and re-enter the event.

TICKETING/WRISTBAND FAQ

For ticket holders, all wristbands will be given at the General Admission or VIP Entrance. There is limited cell and Internet service. We recommend you take a screen shot of your tickets or bring a printed copy of your ticket with QR Code from Universe. Universe will automatically send everyone a reminder email 24 hours prior to the event with their purchased tickets. If you do not receive this email, please contact



info@bearshadownc.com so tickets can be resent. Ticket sales will close 24 hours prior to the start of the event. Tickets will be scanned at the gate and we will assist you with putting on your wristband. No wristbands will be given without a ticket.

What do I need to get into the event?

Just your ticket with QR Code. Kids 10 and under do not need a ticket.

Do not lose your wristband – these are *non-replaceable*. Individuals not wearing a wristband will not be allowed to stay within the festival, no exceptions. The plastic security lock on the wristband is a one-way lock. Do not play with this lock to tighten the band too much. **No wristbands will be replaced.**

***Treat your wristband like cash – lost, stolen, tampered with, and/or confiscated wristbands will not be replaced!**
