live acoustic performance by [Wild Rivers](#) at the mountain summit! Saturday's hike will be to Sunset Rock and through the Highlands Biological Station with an acoustic music performance by [Jamestown Revival](#) at the Biological Station Pavilion.

On Friday all guests will be taken to the trailhead at the Brushy Face Preserve via the Bear Shadow Hike & Mic Shuttle, leaving at 1pm SHARP from Kelsey-Hutchinson Park in Highlands. After the hike, the shuttles will return to the park. Shuttles will begin loading at 12:35pm.

For Saturday, guests are asked to meet at the Highlands Nature Center. There is VERY limited parking, so we ask that you park Downtown and walk a couple of blocks to the Nature Center.

PARKING & SHUTTLES

All guests for Friday's Hike & Mic must ride the shuttles, scheduled to depart Kelsey-Hutchinson Park in downtown Highlands at 1pm sharp.

We ask that you arrive no later than 12:45pm to sign waivers and board the shuttle.



If your lodging location permits, we encourage you to walk to Kelsey-Hutchinson Park for shuttles. Otherwise, please park in public spots and note that parking in Highlands can be challenging.

All guests for Saturday's Hike & Mic are asked to meet at Highlands Nature Center at 12:45pm. There is VERY limited parking, so we encourage you to park in town or at the Hudson Library (544 Main Street) and walk over the Highlands Nature Center.

RESTROOMS

There are very nice public restrooms located at Kelsey-Hutchinson Park, where you will be checking in and boarding the shuttle for Brushy Face Preserve. We strongly recommend you take advantage of the restrooms at the park, before leaving for the hike.

For Saturday's hike, there are restrooms located at the Highlands Nature Center.
